Thought for Today from the Gospel reading

On the fourth Sunday in Lent we mark Mothering Sunday. Although the day has come to focus in recent times more specifically on mothers, traditionally it was a time to return to one's mother church and visit family, celebrating a broader set of caring relationships within a wider community. Today's Scripture readings – Exodus 1:6-2:10 and Luke 13:31-35 – were chosen to help us reflect on the theme 'Who Cares' at our All Together service. In the Exodus reading, we see the care of Moses' mother for her infant son. But he is cared for, too, by the midwives Shiphrah and Puah, his sister Miriam, and his adoptive mother, the Pharaoh's daughter. Each of them plays an important part in keeping Moses safe from the threat that hangs over him – often at personal risk. And behind the scenes, the love of God is at work, preparing Moses to lead God's people to freedom. Several passages in the Old Testament describe people as taking shelter under God's wings, and it is this image that Jesus picks up in our Gospel reading: like a mother hen gathering her chicks under her wings, he longs to embrace the people of Jerusalem. Whatever our own experiences of motherhood, we are all invited to experience the care we give and receive as a part of God's love for the whole human family.




