In today's gospel reading when Jesus sends the disciples out on their mission he gives them authority to cast out unclean spirits and "to cure every disease and every sickness".

The church has always engaged in mission in various ways, from ministering to those locally to spreading the gospel throughout the world – with varying degrees of sensitivity to different cultures.

The current Five Marks of Mission (which every candidate for ordination is required to be familiar with) proclaims the need:

- to proclaim the good news of the Kingdom
- to teach, baptise and nurture (new) Christians
- to respond to human need by loving service
- to seek to transform the unjust structures of society
- to strive to safeguard the integrity of creation and to sustain and renew the life of the earth.

These are tasks that everyone can respond to in many ways. How far are we conscious of carrying these out in our daily lives and how can we support one another in doing so?
