Thought for Today

This week is a special one for me and for many other ordinands and curates across the country: for many of us, this is the week we become deacons or priests. As part of the ordination service, those about to be ordained are told by the bishop: "You cannot bear the weight of this calling in your own strength, but only by the grace and power of God. [...] Pray earnestly for the gift of the Holy Spirit." The readings I have chosen for today encourage each of us to ask: what are our foundations, and can they bear the weight we place on them? For the prophet Haggai, it is the presence and the promise of God that makes possible the rebuilding of the Temple. Paul, writing to the Corinthians, tells them that *they* are God's temple, and their foundation is Christ. And in our Gospel, Jesus tells his hearers that his teaching is like the bedrock: a firm foundation for life. As we all work together for God's Kingdom, each contributing in our own way to build up our communities, let us pray earnestly for the Holy Spirit, and give thanks that in Jesus we have been given solid ground on which to build by the grace and power of God.



There will be a special event for young families at the vicarage on Sunday 16th July 2.30 – 5.00pm.


