Thought for Today

One of my theological heroes Dietrich Bonhoeffer once wrote that 'The believer must live a secular life and thereby share in God's sufferings.' I think that is to do with living in this world with its complexity and this is always going to mean a measure of compromise. This is hinted at in today's gospel reading. When challenged, as we hear, Jesus was ambiguous, he fudged the issue. God engaged in the world. He experienced its cruelty. He felt its pain. I think we are called to live out our faith in ways that that witness our struggle to relate what we believe to the way we live our lives. It is not easy for us. I wonder if others could see our struggle... if we allow ourselves to be vulnerable rather than give the impression that we've got all the answers, then - perhaps - people might be more attracted to the faith we're struggling to live out and learn something more about God?


Following Parish Communion there will be a short open PCC meeting in the Centre.

The Duchess (2008) is a historical drama based on the 1998 book *Georgiana*, *duchess of Devonshire by* Amanda Foreman. Georgiana was an ancestor of Princess Diana in the 18th century and was alternately celebrated and reviled for her extravagant political and personal life. From her passionate and doomed affair with Earl Grey to the complex ménage à trois with her husband and her best friend, Lady Bess Foster, this film has been described as "a very contemporary tale of fame, notoriety and the search for love."
