#### **Thought for Today**

As we pass the halfway point of our journey through Lent, the season's themes of self-reflection and self-denial are put on pause for a week while we celebrate Mothering Sunday, recognizing the importance of mothers and mother figures in all our lives. In or Gospel reading today (John 19: 25-27) we see the love between Jesus and his mother Mary as she stays by his side in the final hours of his earthly life. We also see Jesus forging a new bond between Mary and one of his disciples, so that she becomes his adopted mother and he her adopted son. The other reading I have asked for at our All Together service today is from the book of Ruth. In this story of loss and redemption, we see how kindness, care, devotion, protection and provision can characterise many different relationships within an extended family and a community. At a deeper level, the loving kindness displayed in Ruth points beyond the human dimension towards God as the ultimate source of loving care for all his children. Whatever our own family circumstances, we invited to share in that love today.



# All Saints Book Club – March Meeting The Owl and the Nightingale- Translated by Simon Armitage

Following his acclaimed translation of <u>Sir Gawain and the Green Knight</u>, Simon Armitage shines light on another jewel of Middle English verse. In his highly engaging version, Armitage communicates the energy and humour of the tale with all the cut and thrust of the original.

An unnamed narrator overhears a fierce verbal contest between the two birds, which moves entertainingly from the eloquent and philosophical to the ribald and ridiculous. The disputed issues still resonate - concerning identity, cultural habits, class distinctions and the right to be heard.


