An inbuilt tendency to corruption

The Jewish Temple in Jerusalem, intended as a place of prayer and divine encounter, tragically evolved into a centre of exploitation. The authorities overseeing its operations seemed to have neglected their duties, allowing corruption to seep in unnoticed. This tendency for corruption to infiltrate institutions is all too familiar, as frequently reported in the news. In the case of the Temple, an organisation meant to foster a connection with the divine ended up obstructing it. It's no surprise that Jesus expressed righteous anger at such betrayal.


