Thought for Today

"Doubting Thomas" has gone down in history primarily for just that – refusing to believe that Jesus had risen until he saw the proof for himself. But wasn't he simply asking for the same assurance as the other disciples had received by Jesus' appearance to them? We might wonder why Thomas wasn't present when the risen Jesus first appeared to the disciples. Had he wanted to be alone to express his grief in private? Or was he the kind of person who always missed out on important events?

Much ink has been spilled over the years in debate over the proof of the resurrection and the reliability of the Gospel narratives of the empty tomb. The proof of the resurrection is surely in the lives of the disciples as this previously frightened group of individuals who had been ready to betray and desert Jesus were now empowered by the Holy Spirit to spread the gospel and to live in the light of the resurrection as we read in Acts as they willingly shared their worldly goods for the benefit of all.




