#### Thought for Today

Reflecting on the leadership of Jesus in the Gospel passage reminded me of a hard-to-find quote about the difficulty of leadership that I came across some time ago.

"The drama of actual life, in all its complexity, messiness, and difficulty, makes leadership challenging. Hardly a day goes by without the need to face awkward people and problems. These cry out for wisdom, and that is rarely instantaneous; it needs to have grown over the years, with roots deep in what has been learned by others. Therefore, the leader needs to be resourced deeply while also alert to the reality of the present. There is always the risky necessity of making judgments and taking decisions that have far-reaching consequences. Educational, ethical, and environmental wisdom must lead to practical decision-making, often deciding between two or more seemingly good choices. There is a strain to decision-making when recognising that there is a rarity of easy answers. We are to take the next step without clarity or guarantee, with a vision of what is not yet visible."
