Thought for Today

The miracle of the feeding of the five thousand is told in all four gospels so it must have been considered a significant event. In fact, more than five thousand may have been involved as one version tells that there were "five thousand men besides women and children".

Our rational minds may question the supernatural elements in the story and explain the multiplication of the food as a result of everyone sharing what they might well have brought with them, encouraged by the boy's offer of the loaves and fish but that is just as much of a miracle as a crowd of individuals became a community of sharers.

It's also important to note that, before Jesus does anything, he asks for a response from the disciples. Jesus takes what we have to offer and turns it into abundance. Acts of generosity are capable of multiplying: think of the example of those who have set out to raise a few thousand pounds for charity and have raised much more than they expected as their generosity has inspired others.

Sometimes, however, we may feel that we have nothing to offer, and it's then that we have to rely on Jesus to bear us up as he will always do.

ALL SAINTS CHURCH GOSFORTH: AMNESTY GROUP LETTER JULY 2024

Since September 2023, after the Prime Minister issued a decree requiring all foreign nationals to regularise their status through Egyptian sponsors and payment of fees, the authorities in Egypt have carried out mass arrests of Sudanese refugees for entering or remaining in the country irregularly. Those arrested have been held for up to six weeks in cruel and inhumane conditions of detention, before being forcibly deported to Sudan without individualised assessment of risk on their return or the opportunity to claim asylum or challenge deportation decisions. Tens of thousands of Sudanese nationals remain at risk of arbitrary detention and forced return to Sudan solely.

Dear Minister

Sudanese nationals in Egypt

I am writing to express my grave concern at the arbitrary arrest and detention of Sudanese nationals in Egypt and their forced return to Sudan where armed conflict has raged since April 2023.

These unlawful deportations are taking place without individualised risk assessments or the possibility of claiming asylum. Those detained are being held in cruel and inhumane detention conditions including overcrowding, lack of sanitation and inadequate food.

Many thousands of undocumented Sudanese refugees, including those awaiting appointments with UNCHR, also risk arbitrary detention and forced return to Sudan.

I urge you to halt all collective expulsions to Sudan where people would be at real risk of serious human rights violations. Please also end the arrest of Sudanese nationals solely based on their migration status and release all those arbitrarily detained.


