Thought for this week

Praying the Trinity

I am who I am God above, our Friend, our Breath To praise you is life

This Haiku poem expresses what we celebrate today: The one true God; Our experience of God in three distinct ways; And our fulfilment in communion with God. "I am who I am" is the ancient name of God, given to Moses at the burning bush. The Trinity can be expressed as God **above** us (as Father and authority figure), **alongside** us (as a friend), and **within** us (as breath). Today may I suggest a prayer exercise: Instead of beginning your prayers "In the name of the Father ..." (as you may or may not already do), take a few moments to "pray the Trinity" in a few more words: "I turn to you my Father/ Mother/ Creator/ Source of all being (ad lib., whatever comes to mind); to you Lord Jesus Christ/ my Saviour/ teacher/ brother; and to you Holy Spirit/ Breath of God/ Spirit of love, life, truth ..." This needn't take long. Most of us get into the habit of addressing our prayers to the Father or the Son - and it's good to pray in whatever way enables us to relate most naturally to God. But just for this week why not make a point of "praying the Trinity"? It's a reminder that there is always more to God than we can express or grasp. Happy Trinity Sunday!

MUSIC SUNDAY

The last time Trinity Sunday and Music Sunday fell on the same day was in June 2019. To mark the occasion, the Royal School of Church Music (RSCM) commissioned Joanna Forbes-L'Estrange to write a short piece which could be used as an introit or an anthem. It is this piece, "God the Holy Trinity" which the choir will sing today. The composer says that her aim was "to create a still and prayerful moment within the service. I chose to describe in music the three-in-one nature of the Trinity by restricting myself largely to three-part harmony, and by employing D sharp within the harmonic framework of A major, which creates a tritone."

God the Holy Trinity, make you strong in faith and love, defend you on ev'ry side and guide you in truth and peace. And the blessing of God almighty, the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit be among you and remain with you always. Amen


