When God calls us, He doesn't always include a helpful GPS voice saying, "Turn left in 300 yards or cubits." The Bible is full of journeys where nobody had a clue where they were going, let alone how close they were to arriving!

Take Abraham, for example - he packed up his whole life because God said, "Go to the land I will show you." No coordinates, no travel brochure, just faith. Then there's Moses and the Israelites, who took "wandering in the desert" to a whole new level. The wise men followed a star - imagine explaining that as your travel plan. And the apostles? They went out into the world spreading the news of the resurrection with no idea what awaited them - blessings, beatings, or both.

Honestly, how many of us know where our next step is going to take us? Probably about as much as they did. God's call is often more of a "walk with Me and see". It's an open-ended, trusting kind of journey. And yes, it can be a bit nerve-wracking. But the good news? God is faithful, even when we feel like we're walking in circles.
