Thought for this week

In today's Gospel reading, Jesus tells the disturbing parable of the rich fool - a man who stores up wealth for himself, imagining a future of comfort and ease, only to discover his life is demanded that very night. Jesus doesn't condemn the man for being rich and successful, but for placing his trust in possessions rather than in God. There's no gratitude, no awareness of others, and no sense of the fragility of life. The parable is not so much about wealth as it is about the danger of forgetting who we are and whose we are.

Perhaps to be "rich toward God" means recognising that all we have - our time, our resources, our influence - is a gift. Jesus invites us to live not in fear or self-indulgence, but in generosity and purpose. As we used to pray each Sunday before the Eucharistic prayer, "All things come from you, O Lord," may we use our wealth not only for ourselves, but for the good of others and the glory of God.

Lammas (from the Old English hlaf-mas, meaning loaf mass) is an ancient Christian festival celebrated on 1st August, marking the beginning of the cereal harvest. Once widespread across many communities it is now coming back into favour. Whilst Harvest Festivals celebrate the end of the season, Lammas honours the beginning - the 'first fruits'. This year at All Saints' we are recognising this tradition with special prayers, a small display of fruit and vegetables from local gardens and some freshly-baked bread. 


