### Thought for this week

Every scribe who has become a disciple (*Greek: mathetes*) for the kingdom of heaven is like a man who rules his house, bringing out from his treasure chest things both old and **new** (Matthew 13.52)

This one-verse parable is Matthew's "signature" on his Gospel. His name sounds a bit like the Greek word for "disciple". Matthew loves the Church: it's in Matthew that Jesus says "You are Peter, and on this rock I will build my Church, and the gates of hell shall never prevail against it." And Matthew loves making connections between the old Scriptures he knows and loves, and the always-new experience of following Jesus, hence his constant refrain "This was to fulfil the Scripture." The young Matthew obviously learnt his letters well at Synagogue, which equipped him to become a successful tax administrator. But it also gave him something much more important: prophecies ticking away in his heart and mind like a time-bomb, so he was ready for Jesus to explode into his life. But now Matthew doesn't necessarily expect his own disciples all to have explosive conversions: this text says that old and new can live in harmony, or perhaps stable tension, to fit us for the Kingdom of Heaven.


